Berkeley HeartLab’s advanced cardiovascular testing will give Dr. Sloan information about your cardiovascular risk that is not available through standard cholesterol testing. They will bill your insurance company. If you have a PPO, they will share the risk with your insurance carrier and only bill you the amount in the third column below. Dr. Sloan is not involved in the finances of you getting Berkeley lab. He only offers the service to you.

1. Call Dr. Sloan’s office to **set an appointment** to have your Berkeley lab drawn at **9:00am**. (We only handle 1 patient per day for this lab due to the “handling time” involved). We can draw the lab Monday through Friday unless it is a holiday or the day before a holiday.
2. You must **fast for 12 hours** prior to your test. You can drink water.
3. **Do not have any alcohol 24 hours prior** to your lab being drawn.
4. To ensure that Berkeley HeartLab bills your insurance correctly, **please provide a copy of the front and back of your insurance card**. Once your insurance pays on the claim, you may receive a bill for non-covered services.
5. If you do not have insurance or will be paying cash, please provide payment by check to Berkeley HeartLab, Inc. or provide us with your Visa, Mastercard, or American Express number and expiration date on the requisition form that will be completed at the time of your blood draw.

7. Medicare will pay for the Berkeley tests if you have a diagnosis other than family history.

Here is how it works for tests ordered by Dr. Sloan:

Tests	<u>Maximum</u> you will be billed (Indemnity plans, HMOs, or cash patients)	Amount you will owe after a PPO pays (any PPO)
HDL Gel	\$ 70	\$ 15
LDL Gel	\$ 51	\$ 12
Lipoprotein (a)	\$ 29	\$ 7
Total	\$ 150	\$ 37
